Job Scope:

The above position will be responsible for providing nutritious meals, snacks and beverages to infants and school aged children.

Duties/Objectives:

Ability to prepare meals for preschool children as well as school aged children
Prepare meals in accordance with planned menus and production sheets
Makes any necessary menu changes or substitutions, reports and records such changes as directed
Prepare and serve meals that are timely, palatable and appetizing in appearance
Assure that kitchen and food storage areas are clean and sterilized; and properly arranged at all times
Knowledge of Food Handling Rules & Regulations
Handle food in accordance with sanitary procedures
Work cooperatively with Child Care Supervisor and other staff members
May be called upon to assist in classroom

Minimum Qualifications:

- Legally entitled to work in Canada
- A valid class G driver's license; and reliable transportation would be an asset
- Current Criminal Reference Check and Vulnerable Sector Search required (if position offered)
- Ability to work independently
- Ability to maintain confidentiality at all times
- Must be CPR and Standard First Aid certified or willing to obtain
