



HOUSING ADVISORY COMMITTEE RECRUITMENT

MISSION STATEMENT

To ensure members in need of safe affordable, adequate and suitable housing be provided with fair consistent housing services through the implementation of the Alderville First Nation's Policy subject to the availability of housing funds and land base.

The Housing Advisory Committee is a volunteer based committee that reviews and make recommendations regarding housing issues pertaining to but not limited to the Housing Policy, Repair Loans, RRAP loans and New Housing construction, keeping in compliance with the Alderville First Nation policies.

Mandate:

The key functions to be performed by the committee are as follows:

- To prioritize repair loans along with RRAP loans and present recommendations to Council
- Receiving direction from Council
- The Committee meets monthly from January until May or as required
- Any final decisions made by Council can be challenged by a Band Member as outlined in the Housing Policy

Members:

- A call for additional members will occur annually from the voting membership of Alderville First Nation
- Appropriate staff and /or selected departmental staff who will act as a "resource" when requested.

Tenure:

- Committee member shall commit two years of service and to a maximum of 8 years
