



JOB POSTING: 9 Month Contract Position ASSISTANT WELLNESS WORKER

Are you a people person? Are you organized and outgoing? Are you thinking about a career in Social Services? Here is an opportunity to learn and train!

JOB SCOPE: The Alderville First Nation has a great learning & training opportunity for an energetic and reliable individual to fill the position of **Assistant Wellness Worker**. The successful candidate will work under the direct supervision of the Health & Social Services Manager and will work closely with the Cultural Coordinator to assist with various programs that will include cultural activities and address emerging health, healing and wellness within the First Nation. This position is also responsible for the Food Bank and the Alderville First Nation Emergency Fund.

Duration: Full-Time Contract position starting immediately to March 31, 2019 (~9 months). Office hours at 30 hrs per week will be Monday – Thursday from 8:15am to 4:30pm; **must** be flexible and willing to work evenings and/or weekends as required.

Duties & Responsibilities:

- Organizes and facilitates the bi-weekly food bank; liaises with off-reserve service providers such as Food for All, caterers and outside services as required;
- Assists Cultural Coordinator in organizing and facilitating community events (eg. Cultural awareness, workshops and activities);
- Assists Cultural Coordinator in maintaining and completing work plans and reports as per mandatory funding agreements;
- Works closely with members of the community and the Health and Social Services team;
- Networks effectively and productively with related organizations and agencies both within and outside the community.

Minimum Qualifications:

- Grade 12 diploma or equivalent experience
- Diploma in one of the helping disciplines (eg. Social Work) from a recognized institution **is an asset**
- Demonstrated knowledge and understanding of Native culture, governance, traditions, teachings, community dynamics
- Must have excellent oral & written communication skills, interpersonal skills;
- Must possess a high level of active listening skills, and excellent public relation skills;
- Current CPR, First Aid and AED certificate or willing to obtain (training will be provided)
- Must have valid Class 'G' driver's license with reliable method of transportation
- Current Criminal Reference Check and Vulnerable Sector Search required (if position offered)

- Persons of First Nation ancestry are encouraged to apply and identify themselves in their cover letter

Salary: Alderville First Nation Salary Grid will apply – targeted start rate is \$14.46 - \$15.23 per hour
